"Reporting your incident within the 72-hour timeline has the single greatest impact on whether or not you meet the requirements for **10A NCAC 27G .0604 (Incident Reporting Requirements for Category A & B Providers)**. **Even though you may not have all of the facts related to the incident, submit the report.** As soon as you have the additional information, complete the report. Meeting the timeliness requirement will affect your monitoring score (see below)."

MeckLINK Behavioral Healthcare has the responsibility of monitoring all providers of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse services in accordance with rules, regulations and procedures set forth by the NC Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services (MH/DD/SAS). The State has mandated all LME/MCOs to utilize PBH/Cardinal Innovations' **Gold Star Provider Monitoring System**.



GOALS OF THE GOLD STAR PROVIDER MONITORING SYSTEM

- (1) To implement an appropriate qualification and evaluation system by which to measure the performance of the providers with which the LME-MCO contracts
- (2) To ensure that all providers in the LME-MCO comply with North Carolina standards and rules, 1915(b)(c) waiver requirements and contract guidelines
- (3) To institute procedures to assure and to recognize quality service provision
